
This summer, Manna Cafe lost five people we cared about deeply in less than five weeks.

Life is difficult, to put it mildly, for the homeless. Our mission at Manna is to offer our homeless clients a hand up, whether a hot meal, rehab services, shelter from freezing weather, or job placement assistance. As we invest in people's lives, they move quickly from clients to friends — some would even say family. They're our peeps for whom we gladly go the second mile not because it's easy but because that's simply what we do. When any of our five friends needed guidance or simply wanted to sit and have a conversation, our staff and volunteers treated them with kindness, and that's a great comfort to me.

The death of a client who's become a friend is one of the most difficult aspects of ministry and nonprofit work, and these recent losses left us reeling. True to form, however, several staff members and volunteers channeled their grief by pulling together memorial services for all five of our friends so they'd be remembered and honored. I'd like to do the same through this brief commentary.


