A Lot Got Done Last Month

Due to the generosity of our donors, Manna Cafe provided Montgomery and Stewart County residents with:

- 3,963 hot meals at our Mobile Cafe locations
 - 2,481 carts of food
- 160 hot showers for the homeless
- case work benefits for 78 clients
- 28,000 pounds of food distributed at our mobile pantry
